Requirements to Enter: 2023 IHC (or provincial equivalent) membership.

Off-Site Competitors: *Arrival starting at 8:00am Saturday*. Limited trailer parking due to season mud, no stalls available. Please contact Show Manager with any special requests.

Show Attire:

Rider: Lesson Attire:

- Riding boots with heel (half chaps or tall boots)
- Breaches or tights (Tan preferred)
- Black or Brown Belt
- Form fitting shirt or jacket (no hoodies, show jackets encouraged)
- SSEI Helmet
- Hair tied back neatly

Horse:

- Clean, well-groomed mounts
- Braids are not required but encouraged.

Tack:

- White saddle pads preferred but not required. (Shaped or square)
- Boots & Polos: Allowed
- Fly Bonnets: Allowed

Show Office: The Show office will open at 7:30am on the day of the show and close by 5:00pm. It will be located inside the barn with signage. Competitors must check in before entering the facility to receive their competitor package with ring numbers.

Warm-ups: Due to mud season, we will most likely only have use of the indoor arena. Therefore, warmups will be offered for 5 minutes before each division for those entered in that division only. If footing permits, the outdoor arena will be available. The indoor ring will also be available from 7:30am to 8:50am for all competitors to warm up. Jumps available in the ring for warm up will be marked and the rest will be off limits until the class starts.

Parking: All Competitors and Spectators will park on the sides of the driveway leading up to the facility unless otherwise advised. Additional parking will be on the side of the Dock Road. We apologize to those that will have to walk a distance to the facility. Due to mud season, parking is limited near arena.

Spectator Area: A designated Spectator Area will be set up in the arena, no chairs will be available, so please bring a lawn chair if you would like.

<u>Canteen</u>: The HCEC Canteen will open at **10:00 am** and close at **2:00 pm**. A full menu will be posted within the week leading up to the show. Onsite guests can expect a sandwiches, soups, snacks and drinks. Cash or e-transfer payments accepted.

Prizes & Awards: Ribbons will be given for each class to 5th place unless otherwise stated. Special Awards with prizes from our Sponsors will be offered to competitors. If a winner has already left, arrangements will be made to deliver award and prize at a later time. *Prizes to be announced*. No championships or reserve championships will be given.

- Sportsmanship Award Awarded to the Entry that shows the best sportsmanship.
- Best Turned-out Jr Rider Award Awarded to the best Hunter show attire Junior Mini.
- Best Turned-out Sr Rider Award Awarded to the best Hunter show attire Senior Mini.
- Best Turned-out Horse Award Awarded to the best Hunter show turnout horse.
- Team Spirit Award Awarded to the Club or Barn that shows the best team spirit.

Competition Rules & Regulations:

- The Show Committee, The PEI Hunter & Jumper Association, its officials, Island Horse Council, and Bonwell Park will not be held responsible for any loss, illness or injury to horse, rider, grooms, volunteers, officials, and spectators at this competition.
- The abuse or inhumane treatment of a horse by an exhibitor, trainer, or other person shall not be tolerated. Such abuse of a horse may result in a penalty, forfeit of prizes, and asked to leave the show grounds.
- Pets MUST be on a leash at all times while on the show grounds and not disruptive to competitors or horses/ponies during the show. Owners must pick up and properly dispose of their pet's excrement.
- Day-of Scratches will not be reimbursed.
- All over fence classes will have a 3-refusal limit before the rider is excused.
- The Show Committee and its Officials have the right to expel any rider, owner or spectator deemed to be in their sole discretion disruptive to the show at any time.
- Absolutely "NO" smoking permitted on show grounds. Please go to marked smoking area.
- The use of a cell phone while mounted is not permitted on the show grounds. We encourage safety at all times. Any horse that becomes out of control shall be eliminated from the competition at the discretion of the judge.

<u>Falls</u>: If a fall occurs during a class, the rider is required to leave the ring un-mounted and to be checked out by First Aid before re-mounting. In any circumstance where a head injury is suspected medical attention must be sought and Return to Play guidelines will be adhered to.

<u>**Class Adds:**</u> All riders must write their add of class on the add sheet before riding that class. Riders must pay for their adds before the horse may leave the property.

<u>Admin Fee:</u> An admin fee of \$30 will be applicable to all entries except Leadline riders. All PEI HJA 2023 Members and Holland College Equestrian Club Members will also have their admin fee waived.

Photography: The Organizing committee and sponsors reserves the right to use competitor photographs in promotional material and on social media unless another arrangement is made in writing with the Organizing Committee. A Show Photographer will be hired to capture all riders throughout the show and photos will be available for purchase.

<u>Refunds:</u> In the event of a cancelled Entry, no refunds will be issued in any circumstance.

Facility: There will be washroom facilities on site including a port a potty.

<u>Ring Number:</u> Each rider must wear their ring number at all times when mounted. No deposit is required, and competitors may keep their ring number or return them if they choose.

UNRATED GRASSROOTS DIVISIONS AND CLASSES

All classes will be restricted to not less than 3 competitors or will run at the discretion of the Show Committee.

Lead Line

Open to pony or horse to be ridden by a child 10 years of age or under as of January 1st of the current year. To walk, trot or jog & be led by an adult. Riders in this class are only permitted to enter POG Division (Class 10, 11, 12 & 13) if the rider would like. IHC or equivalent Provincial membership is required for insurance purposes.

Rider must be in proper riding attire including proper boots and helmet.

Class 5 ~ Lead Line

Class fee: \$10.00 (admin fee waived). No prize money. Ribbons and prizes for all entries.

<u>Red Ribbon Schooling Rounds</u>

Red Ribbon Rounds will be offered for each Division. Riders will be allowed to enter the ring and jump the course from O/F #1. This round will not be judged but all clear rounds will receive a red ribbon. Riders with **three refusals** or stops will be asked to leave the ring. These Schooling Rounds are provided for green horses or riders. Coaches will be allowed to coach riders from the ring. Round Fee: \$10 each

Equitation Classes

Judging of hunter seat equitation at the College Royal is based on the following criteria:

- The rider's position should be efficient, effective, balanced, and supple.
- It should not be exaggerated or rigid and should allow for aids to be discrete.
- Riders' stirrups should be of appropriate length. Stirrups should meet the rider's anklebone when the leg is fully extended, and the rider is sitting squarely in the saddle. Stirrup irons should rest on the ball of the rider's foot.
- The rider's body position should be upright, and the seat should be centered in the deepest part of the saddle.
- Legs should be in contact with horse with a slight bend in the knee and heel inclined downward.
- Reins should be tight enough to ensure control and hands should be held above the horse's withers.
- Rider will have a "deep seat" at all gaits, as opposed to the half seat shown in the traditional Hunter under saddle classes.

Riders will be asked to complete a minimum of two tests per division to assist in judging. POG Green Division can only be asked to halt and sitting trot.

The under-saddle tests are as follows:

- Halt (halt execution will be judged on the rider not the horses halting ability)
- Sitting trot
- Extended and/or collected trot
- Trot without stirrups posting (stirrup leathers may not be crossed)
- Trot without stirrups sitting (stirrup leathers may not be crossed)
- Two-point at the walk or trot or canter

POG Green Hunter Division

Open to all riders on horse or pony.

To be judged over a course of at least 6 "hunter fences" of poles laid on the ground. Open to horse or pony, but distances will not be adjusted. Under Saddle class to be judged on the walk and trot only. Horses may pick up the canter 3 strides before and/or after the jump or in a line but must regain the trot otherwise to demonstrate skill and to not be penalized. Riders are asked to demonstrate a proper 2-point position over each "jump". Horses or ponies may show in other classes with a different rider. This Division will be divided into Junior and Senior riders who will be judged separately. Junior riders are those under the age of 18 as of January 1st, 2023. *Discrete coaching from the ringside will be permitted*.

Mini Hunter Division

Open to all riders on horse or pony.

To be judged over a course of at least 6 hunter fences not exceeding 18 inches and will include only cross rails. Open to horse or pony, but distances will not be adjusted from horses to ponies. Under Saddle class to be judged on the walk, trot, and canter. Riders may not cross enter any other over fences classes exceeding 2ft. Horses or ponies may show in other classes with a different rider. This Division will be divided into Junior and Senior riders who will be judged separately. Junior riders are those under the age of 18 as of January 1st, 2023. *Discrete coaching from the ringside will be permitted*.

Entry Hunter Division

Open to all riders on horse or pony.

To be judged over a course of at least 8 hunter fences not exceeding 2 ft, will include verticals and cross rails. Open to horse or pony, but distances will not be adjusted from horses to ponies. Riders may not cross enter any other over fences classes exceeding 2'3. Horses or ponies may show in other classes with a different rider.

Class Fee: \$10 each / \$30 per division No Prize Money. Ribbons to 5th place. No Champion or Reserve Champion for this Division

Novice Hunter Division

Open to all riders on horse or pony.

To be judged over a course of at least 8 hunter fences not exceeding 2'3. Open to horse or pony, but distances will not be adjusted from horses to ponies. Riders may not cross enter any other over fences classes exceeding 2'6. Horses or ponies may show in other classes with a different rider. For Green Riders or Horses wanting to grow. May enter Team Class (2'3)

To be judged over a course of at least 8 hunter fences not to exceed 2'6. Open to horse or pony, but distances will not be adjusted from horses to ponies. May enter Team Class at 2'3.

To be judged over a course of at least 8 hunter fences. Class will be built of teams of 3 riders. Horses and ponies welcome. Riders are encouraged to dress up themselves and their mounts. Music may be played during your team's rounds. Team names encouraged. Course will be Handy Hunter Style with a score out of 100 and each teammate will go once. The team with the highest combined score wins. Height Option: 2' (Crossrails) & 2'3.

Class 40 ~ Team Class

Fee: \$30 per team *Ribbons per team to 3rd place and prizes!*
